

It's impossible to tell if there is a grave at corner A1.

Graves marking the corners of Zone A are:


A2 Harry Burgess d.1985 aged 69

A16 James Wallace d. 19081 aged 52

T1 Robert John Harper d. 1977 Frederick G. White 2. 1974 ages 74
T18 George W. Douras d. 1979 aged 59

The Zone can be divided between two volunteers as follows:

Rows A - J and Rows K - T The grave at J17 is: Elsie Bank d.1965 aged 61



Graves marking the corners of this Zone are as follows:

A1: No information on grave

B1: Leonard David Banks d. 1958 (?) aged 31 (?)

J1: No details on grave

Alice Maude Pitt d. 1961 aged 41


A44: No information on grave

A 43 Ball: Thomas Benjamin Davies d. 1951 aged 43 etc

J44: Florence Ellen Mattox d. 1949 aged 57

A43; A42 , A41

Note that graves at A44 and B44 are separated by the bend in the path from others in Zone B



Graves marking the corners of this Zone are as follows:

A1: A1 - rough ground

A2: George Edward Bradley d. 1959 aged 56

A38: Reginald Vincent (d. 1972 aged 69) & Emmie Hilda Durham (d. 1962 aged 49)


G39: rough ground

G38: Arthur Thomas Day d. 1950 aged 73

F3: Arthur Gibbons d. 1980 aged 59.

There is a wedge of ground between rows B and C (see the top of the plan) with several graves in, only three of which are identifiable.


At the bottom right corner of Zone C, there are two graves that are out of line from the others (eg. Gerald Crutchley d. 1952 aged 3 weeks)



Graves marking the three corners of Zone D are as follows:

A1: Howard Stephen Wilkes d. 1946 aged 57
D1: John Telford Benn d. 1947 aged 22 etc
D30: Ronald Mackenzie Wright d. 1943 aged 78

Note that an element of guesswork was involved in reckoning Row D to contain 30 graves because there are rough areas which may accommodate either one grave or two.



Graves marking the corners of Zone E are as follows:

Williams

Graves at A1 and B2 cannot be identified. The grave at C1 is that of Martha Willington (d. 1947) F1 - John Giles d. 1948 etc

There is a tree at A32. The grave at B32 is that of Edward John Williams d. 1941 F34 - William Bentley d. 1946.

Note that there appears to be 32 graves in Row A but 34 in Row F
