

Show rules

1. The show is open to all members of the public.
2. The general public, stallholders and competitors are not allowed in the Centre during the judging of exhibits.
3. Prize giving ceremony will be at 3.30pm
4. All exhibits in the categories of vegetables, fruit, floral art, food and drink, excluding juniors (classes 1-20) will be auctioned at 4pm. Exhibits in other categories should be collected by 6pm.
5. Prizes awarded in each class:
 - 1st Prize Rosette and certificate;
 - 2nd Prize Certificate;
 - 3rd Prize Certificate
6. An overall award will be made to "Best in show"



7. For all photography classes, photos including people are permissible if the photo has been taken at a public event. Otherwise the photo is permitted if express written permission has been provided by the individual (or parent/guardian if under 18). Photographs which do not meet these guidelines will not be displayed, at the discretion of the judges.
8. The judges' decisions are final. No appeals are permitted
